

#2354 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 613, Hebron Massacre of August 23-24, 1929, (xxxvi), Repeat of Unsealing #2299 for the purpose of connecting Woodrow Wilson as the Daniel 9:26 “prince that shall come” in World War I with the 1929 Hebron Massacre, which points to Daniel 9:25, “the street shall be built again, and the wall”

Key Understanding: Below is a repeat of the content (but not the title) of Unsealing #2299 for the purpose of attaching (a) Woodrow Wilson and World War I to (b) the Hebron Massacre, because each of those events is a part of the fulfillment of the passage of Daniel 9:24-27. Keep in mind that Woodrow Wilson is squarely attached to Daniel 9:26.

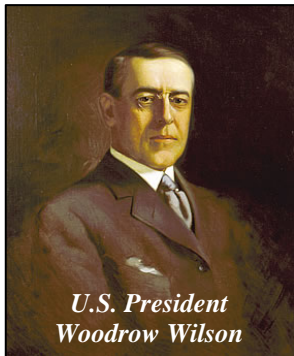


Austrian Archduke Franz Ferdinand

Key Understanding #1: Why a “prince” was assassinated to start World War I. The Lord ordained the assassination of a prince, Archduke Franz Ferdinand, who was the heir to the throne of a kingdom, the Austrian-Hungarian Empire, to ignite World War I, for the purpose of the fulfillment of “the prince that shall come” in Daniel 9:26. The fulfillment of “the prince that shall come” of Daniel 9:26 centers around the theme of a prince inheriting a throne, which is why the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand is a central event toward the fulfillment of the passage.

Daniel 9:26 (KJV) And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of

shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.

Key Understanding #2: “The prince that shall come” indicates a new prince. The prophetic point behind the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand is not only that he himself would not be inheriting the throne, but that a new prince – “the prince that shall come” – would be inheriting the throne and role of the Austrian Empire as a successor Holy Roman Empire of the West.
