

#2401 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 660, **Building the Christian-Jewish-Arab Temple, (xxxix), The Civil War and World War I: The Double ‘Days of the Lord’**

**The double of the Civil War and World War I.** The significance of the U.S. Civil War and World War I being prophetically coupled together as a *double* has been discussed in the Unsealings before, including Unsealing [#1052](#) The Revelation 3:21 Grant – Three chief *counterfeit* overcomers of Revelation 3:21: (i) U.S. Grant and the *Joel’s Former Rain Union Army of April 9, 1865*, (ii) Edward Lee and the *April 9, 1906, Latter Rain-Latter Reign*, and (iii) Woodrow Wilson and the *Joel’s Latter Rain Man o’ War U.S. Army of April 6 [= 9], 1917*. [However, we will not be reviewing Unsealing [#1052](#).]

**‘The Day of the Lord’ double of the Civil War and World War I.** In Unsealings [#1092](#) and [#1107](#) appeared the following two written paragraphs (*below*) about the double of the Civil War and World War I surrounding the theme of ‘the Day of the Lord’:

- The day of April 6, 1917, was a day of both the *counterfeit* “coming of Elijah” (and Moses, as we shall see), as well as a *counterfeit* “day of the Lord,” for it represented a Woodrow Wilson-led Revelation 6:2 White Horse Rider judgment of America’s enemies, similar to that of its twin, the Civil War’s (and the Battle Hymn of the Republic’s) **“Mine eyes have seen the glory of the coming of the Lord.”**



- While April 6, 1917, was a *counterfeit* “day of the Lord” for what it was representing in the eyes of the judging Church-ill, it actually represented a *true* (but not ultimate) “day of the Lord,” for through it the Lord indeed judged (i) the four empires of Russia, Germany, Austria-Hungary, and the Ottomans through World War I, and (ii) judged the Church-ill for their judgment, by casting the Church-ill further into the arms of Babylon the Great.
