

#2429 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 688, **Building the Christian-Jewish-Arab Temple, (Ixvii), William Pitt, the Younger, and the deliverance of Palestine from the Ottoman Turks, to see Israel’s (re)birth attached to the pit, just as America’s birth was attached to the Revelation 17:08 pit**

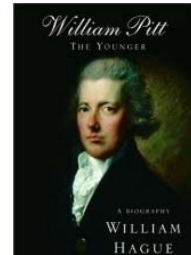
Review (from the previous two Unsealings): *World War I and Revelation 17:08 and Genesis 17:08*. At the time of the World War I *second* ascension of the Revelation 17:08 Beast out of the Pit (which upon its *first* ascension was masquerading as the Lord’s Christian New Israel conquering New Canaan), it delivered the land of Old Canaan (Palestine) back to the Jews as a *counterfeit* latter day(s) fulfillment of Genesis 17:08. Key Understanding #1: William Pitt, the younger, and the deliverance of Palestine from the Ottoman Turks. The capture/deliverance of Palestine by General Edmund Allenby in 1917-1918 was tied to William Pitt, the Younger, prime minister of Great Britain from 1783-1801 and from 1804-1806 (reference Unsealing #733), to further emphasize that the deliverance of Palestine and the subsequent May 14-15, 1948, birth of Israel were from the pit. Thus, while America’s birth was from the pit, represented by William Pitt, the Elder, and attached to Revelation 17:08, Palestine’s deliverance and Israel’s rebirth were also from the pit, represented by William Pitt, the Younger, and attached to Genesis 17:08.

*Revelation 17:08 (KJV) **THE BEAST** that thou sawest was, and is not; and **SHALL ASCEND OUT OF THE BOTTOMLESS PIT**, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, . . .*

*Genesis 17:08 (KJV) And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, **THE LAND WHEREIN THOU ART A STRANGER, ALL THE LAND OF CANAAN**, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their God.*

Key Understanding #2: How William Pitt, the younger, was tied to the deliverance of Palestine from the Ottoman Turks. The Staffordshire Yeomanry (Queen's Own Royal Regiment) was a unit of the British Army. Raised in 1794 following Prime Minister William Pitt's (the Younger's) order to raise volunteer bodies of men to defend Great Britain from foreign invasion, the Staffordshire Yeomanry began as a volunteer cavalry regiment. It first served overseas at the time of the Boer War, and was involved in distinguished action in Egypt and Palestine in the First World War.

The story. Pitt the Younger's Staffordshire Yeomanry was ordered to join the Egyptian Expeditionary Force in 1915. The Regiment was attached to the Yeomanry Mounted Division in the Sinai and Palestine campaign against the Ottoman Turkish and German army in 1916-1918. It fought in the indecisive First Battle of Gaza and Second Battle of Gaza in March and April 1917. They finally won through in the Third Battle of Gaza (October 31 – November 7, 1917) on November 6, 1917, where Allied victory at last left the field open for the capture of Jerusalem on December 9, 1917. In July 1918 the Division was reformed as the Fourth Cavalry Division under the command of General Edmund Allenby and the Regiment played a key role in the decisive Battle of Megiddo in September 1918.
