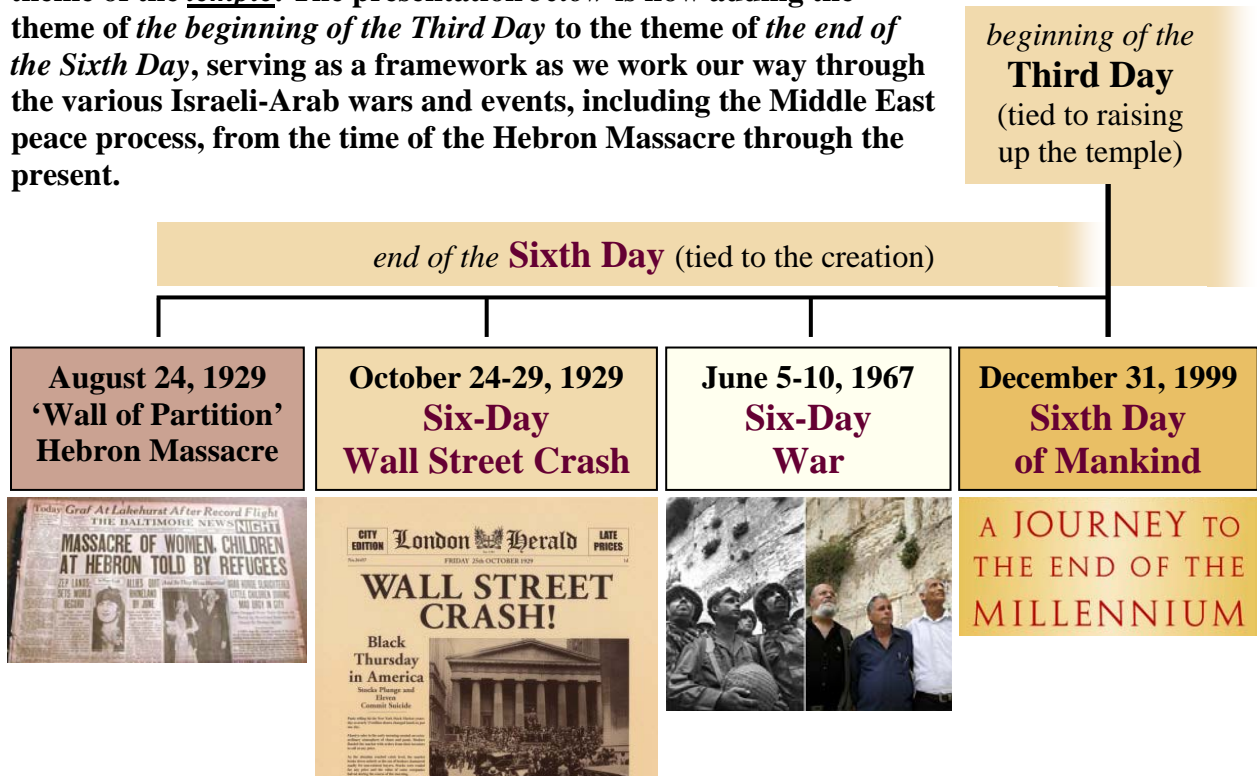


#2457 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 716, Building the Christian-Jewish-Arab Temple, (xcv), Correlating the Six-Day theme with the raising up of the counterfeit Temple on the Third Day

Key Understanding #1: *The start of the third day.* It is because of the theme of “*destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up*” (John 2:19) that the *building* (and *destruction*, as we will discover) of the *counterfeit* temple is attached to *the end* of the second millennium/*beginning* of the third millennium (from the approximate time of the birth of Jesus Christ, and 1 A.D.), which are representing *the beginning* of the Third Day.

Key Understanding #2: *Correlating the sixth day and the third day.* *The end of the Sixth Day (or the beginning of the Seventh Day) corresponds to the beginning of the Third Day.* The Sixth Day has as its basis the creation of the world by the Lord, while the Third Day has as its basis the raising up, or resurrection, of the temple of God.

Key Understanding #3: *Correlating the sixth day and the third day.* *The end of the Sixth Day (or the beginning of the Seventh Day) corresponds to the beginning of the Third Day, with both the ending of the Sixth Day and the beginning of the Third Day themes surrounding the theme of the temple.* The presentation below is now adding the theme of *the beginning of the Third Day* to the theme of *the end of the Sixth Day*, serving as a framework as we work our way through the various Israeli-Arab wars and events, including the Middle East peace process, from the time of the Hebron Massacre through the present.
