

#2563 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 822, **The 1947-1948 Tribe of Dan, (xxiii), The inheritance of Dan in Joshua 19:40-48**

Key Understanding: The inheritance of the tribe of Dan is seen in Joshua 19:40-48.

Joshua 19:40-48 (KJV) And the seventh lot came out for the tribe of the children of Dan according to their families. 41 And the coast of their inheritance was Zorah, and Eshtaol, and Irshemesh, 42 And Shaalabbin, and Ajalon, and Jethlah, 43 And Elon, and Thimnathah, and Ekron, 44 And Eltekeh, and Gibbethon, and Baalath, 45 And Jehud, and Beneberak, and Gathrimmon, 46 And Mejarkon, and Rakkon, with the border before Japho.

47 And the coast of the children of Dan went out too little for them: therefore the children of Dan went up to fight against Leshem, and took it, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and possessed it, and dwelt therein, and called Leshem, Dan, after the name of Dan their father. 48 This is the inheritance of the tribe of the children of Dan according to their families, these cities with their villages.



Dan. The area allotted to the tribe of Dan included the towns of Ajalon (Ajalon), Ekron, Eltekeh, and Zorah in the west central part of Canaan (Joshua 19:40-46; 21:5, 23-24) and stretched to Joppa (Japho) on the Mediterranean Sea. The Danites, however, were unable to conquer much of the territory assigned to them. The original inhabitants, the Amorites, kept the

Danites confined to the hill country of Ephraim and Benjamin. Unable to conquer their allotted territory, some members of the tribe of Dan migrated far to the northernmost area of the Promised Land and conquered the isolated city of Laish (Leshem), which they renamed Dan (Joshua 19:47).
