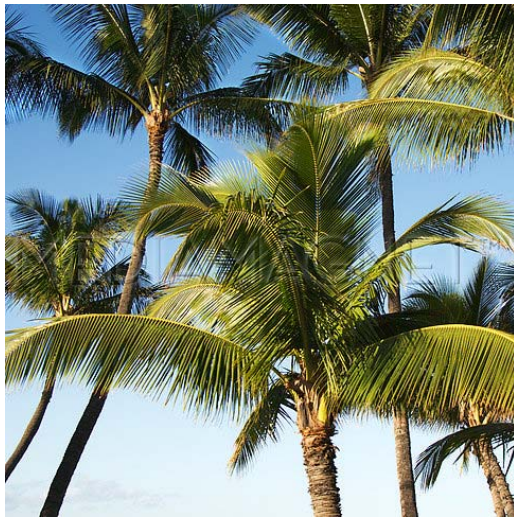


#2612 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 871, **The Palm Christians, (ii), John 12:12-15 and Revelation 7:9**

Key Understanding: Palm Sunday. The background behind the theme of those with *palms in their hands* in Revelation 7:9 is the John 12:12-15 ‘Palm Sunday’ event of Jesus Christ entering into Jerusalem.

*John 12:12-15 (KJV) On the next day **much people** that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,*
*13 **TOOK BRANCHES OF PALM TREES**, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.*
14 And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written,
15 Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass’s colt.



*Revelation 7:9-10 (KJV) After this I beheld, and, lo, **a great multitude**, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, **AND PALMS IN THEIR HANDS**;*
10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.

Why? The question is, *why* is the background behind the theme of those with *palms in their hands* in Revelation 7:9 the John 12:12-15 ‘Palm Sunday’ event of Jesus Christ entering into Jerusalem? What is the underlying meaning of *palms in their hands*?
