

#2789 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 1048, **Palm Beach to Judging Pretender Babylon, (xc), Repeat of Unsealing #1878 about the May 5, 1961, flight of Alan Shepard, which started a fulfillment of “one hour with the beast” (Revelation 17:12)**

#1878 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 137, **An Angel riding in the Whirlwind and directing the Storm: The Micah 5:5 Assyrian vs. the Micah 5:5 Seven Shepherds, (xi), Freedom 7 and its companions, Liberty Bell 7, Friendship 7, Aurora 7, Sigma 7, and Faith 7**

Freedom 7. The name *Freedom 7* was painted on the side of the capsule that carried Alan Shepard (*right*) on May 5, 1961. *Freedom* had been chosen because it was patriotic. The numeral 7 was included with *Freedom* because the capsule was the seventh Mercury capsule produced (capsule No. 7) on booster rocket No. 7, and because Shepard’s flight would be the first of an expected series of seven (7) flights. The numeral 7, however, soon became more strongly associated with the Original Seven astronauts and, for that reason, was included in the call sign for each of the remaining Mercury missions, which ended up only totaling six (6) in all. *Below* is a summary of the six (6) missions. The seventh (in alphabetical order) of the Original Seven, astronaut Deke Slayton, did not fly a Mercury mission due to a heart condition.

Key Understanding #1: The Lord ordained Alan Shepard's capsule to be named *Freedom 7* and the other spacecrafts of the Mercury Seven to include the number "7" in their names, to represent the *counterfeit* fulfillment of the *seven shepherds* of Micah 5:5. However, although there were seven (7) scheduled missions for the Original Seven, one for each astronaut, only six (6) of the men flew, because the Lord was illustrating that NASA's *seven (7) shepherds*, instead of representing the *Lord*, were the *six (6) shepherds*, representing *man*.

Key Understanding #2: Obviously, the theme encompassing the *counterfeit seven shepherds* is freedom, vs. the tyranny represented by "*the Assyrian*" Soviet Union.

Micah 5:5-6 (KJV) And this man shall be the peace, WHEN THE ASSYRIAN SHALL COME INTO OUR LAND: and when he shall tread in our palaces, THEN WE SHALL RAISE AGAINST HIM SEVEN SHEPHERDS, and eight principal men.

6 And they shall waste the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in the entrances thereof: THUS SHALL HE DELIVER US FROM THE ASSYRIAN, when he cometh into our land, and when he treadeth within our borders.
