

#2816 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 1075, **Jackson Wild Ass Men, (i), Man is born like a wild ass's colt**

The Unsealings are making the transition from the 2nd Edition of the Decline and Fall of the Roman Empire to **Jackson Wild Ass Men**.


There are two key verses for **Jackson Wild Ass Men**. The first verse is Job 11:12.

Job 11:12 (KJV) For vain man would be wise, THOUGH MAN BE BORN LIKE A WILD ASS'S COLT.

[Note: The NIV translates Job 11:12 substantially differently than does the KJV, but the true nature of the meaning of the passage seems to be better rendered in the KJV, an opinion that is confirmed by the verse's place in prophetic history. In short, the verse indicates that man is born at his natural birth with an unsubdued nature, without submission to the Holy Spirit, and the Lord uses the verse to reveal prophecy with that theme in mind.]



Key Understanding: Man is born like a wild ass's colt. The significance of the matter is enormous, for the Declaration of Independence's words regarding mankind's right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness – which are based upon the Age of Reason/Age of Enlightenment doctrine of the natural birthrights of men – are to be joined with the understanding that man is born like a wild ass's colt. The fact that man is born like a wild ass's colt is exactly why one must be *born again*. [Reference Unsealings #270–#279.]



John 3:1-8 (KJV) There was a man of the Pharisees, named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews:

2 The same came to Jesus by night, and said unto him, Rabbi, we know that thou art a teacher come from God: for no man can do these miracles that thou doest, except God be with him.

3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, EXCEPT A MAN BE BORN AGAIN, he cannot see the kingdom of God.

4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?



5 *Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.*

6 *That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.*

7 *Marvel not that I said unto thee, **YE MUST BE BORN AGAIN.***

8 *The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: **so is every one that is born of the Spirit.***
