

#2819 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 1078, **Jackson Wild Ass Men, (iv), ‘All men are created equal’ goes with the creation of man on the sixth day, and man being born like a wild ass’s colt**

*Job 11:12 (KJV) For vain man would be wise, **THOUGH MAN BE BORN LIKE A WILD ASS’S COLT.***

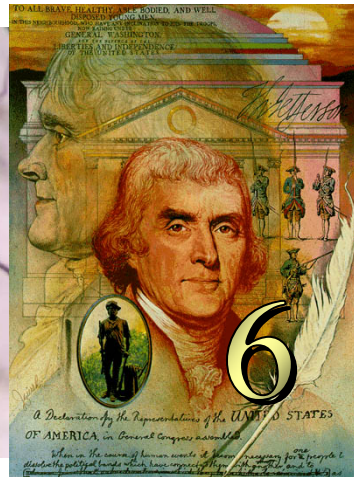
*Genesis 1:27 (KJV) **SO GOD CREATED MAN** in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.*

*Genesis 1:31 (KJV) And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were **THE SIXTH DAY.***

Key Understanding #1: ‘All men are created equal’ and the creation of man. The belief that *all men are created equal* that is expounded upon in the United States Declaration of Independence, and that is attached to the Age of Reason/Age of Enlightenment doctrines of the *natural birthrights* of men, is also obviously and completely attached to the scriptural understandings of the *creation of man on the sixth day, and man being born like a wild ass’s colt.*

Thomas Jefferson’s U.S. Declaration of Independence:

We hold these truths to be self-evident, that **all men are created equal**, that **they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights** [and thus “God-given Unalienable Rights”], that among these are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness.



Key Understanding #2: The theme of six and man being born like a wild ass’s colt. Therefore (referring to Key Understanding #1), the theme of six is tied to *man being born like a wild ass’s colt.*
