


#2841 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 1100, Jackson Wild Ass Men, (xxvi), The 188 years from the end of the War of 1812 to the start of the Iraq War includes two of “her double”

Review: *Jackson wars.* There were 188 years (+ 2 months and 11 days) between Andrew Jackson’s January 8, 1815, victory at the Battle of New Orleans, which was the ending event of the War of 1812, and the March 19, 2003, start of the ‘Jackson’ Iraq War.

Key Understanding: *Her double.* The passage of Revelation 18:6-10 includes *two* fulfillments of the theme of “*her double*” that is seen in Revelation 18:06 that surround the 188 years between the end of the War of 1812 and the start of the Iraq War.

- (i) *Her double.* First, the end of the War of 1812 represented the end of the *second* American war for independence from Great Britain. Remember, the wars against Great Britain represented the *start* of America’s history, while the Cold War victory of the U.S. over the *pretender* Revelation 17 scarlet beast Soviet Union represented the “*time of the end*” seen in Daniel 12:8-9.
- (ii) *Her double.* Secondly, there is the “double” of the War of 1812 against Great Britain, which is ultimately linked with the Cold War victory of the U.S. over the *pretender* scarlet beast [see (i) above], and the start of the Iraq War against the regime of Saddam Hussein, which was representing *pretender* Babylon the Great.
