

**#2842** The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 1101, Jackson Wild Ass Men, (xxvii), March 19, 2003: The Revelation 18:8 “one day” of March 19, 2003, the ‘Jackson’ day of judgment of the regime of Saddam Hussein in Iraq

**Review:** *Jackson wars.* There were 188 years (+ 2 months and 11 days) between Andrew Jackson’s January 8, 1815, victory at the Battle of New Orleans, which was the ending event of the War of 1812, and the March 19, 2003, start of the ‘Jackson’ Iraq War.

**Key Understanding:** *The 188 years are in fulfillment of Revelation 18:8.* The 188 years (+ 2 months and 11 days) between the January 8, 1815, end of the War of 1812 and the March 19, 2003, start of the ‘Jackson’ Iraq War represent the fulfillment of Revelation 18:8, *but in the counterfeit*, with *pretender* Babylon the Great’s plagues coming in ONE DAY. In this case, the *one day* is represented by the literal one day of March 19, 2003, when the United States and Great Britain brought ‘shock and awe’ to the Saddam Hussein regime in Iraq, which soon led to the regime’s demise. However, the event points to the judgment of the *real* Babylon the Great, the United States of America.



**Revelation 18:6-10 (KJV)** Reward her even as she rewarded you, and **DOUBLE UNTO HER DOUBLE** according to her works: in the cup which she hath filled **FILL TO HER DOUBLE**.  
 7 How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.  
 8 **THEREFORE SHALL HER PLAGUES COME IN ONE DAY** [the ‘shock and awe’ day of March 19, 2003, which soon led to the end of the regime of Saddam Hussein], **death, and**

***mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her.***

*9 And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her, shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning,*

*10 Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for in one hour is thy judgment come.*
