

#2875 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 1134, **The Second City of Babylon, (x), The Sox: The city of Chicago was laid out on August 4, 1830; Charlie Comiskey, owner of the Chicago White Sox, was born 29 years (+ 11 days) later, on August 15, 1859**

August 4, 1830, the birth of Chicago. The first map of the original town of Chicago, by James Thompson, the surveyor, is dated August 4, 1830. This date marked the beginning of Chicago as a legally recognized town.

29 years (+ 11 days) later . . .

August 15, 1859, the birth of the owner of the Chicago White Sox. Charlie Comiskey, a major league baseball player, manager, and team owner, was born on August 15, 1859. He was instrumental in the formation of the American League and later owned the Chicago White Sox. Comiskey Park, the storied baseball stadium of the Chicago White Sox, was built under his guidance and named for him.

Review (from the previous Unsealing): The Lord ordained one of the two major league baseball franchises located in Chicago to be called the *White Sox* because the United States, which is represented by the city of Chicago as the Second City of Babylon, represents the *feet* and *toes* of Nebuchadnezzar's image.

Key Understanding: *The Sox city.* The August 15, 1859, birth of Charlie Comiskey, owner of the Chicago *White Sox*, occurred 29 years (+ 11 days) after the August 4, 1830, birth of the city of Chicago so as to emphasize the role of Chicago in representing the United States of America as the *feet* and *toes* of Nebuchadnezzar's image.

The second city of Babylon (Babylon the Great)

*Daniel 2:41 (KJV) And whereas thou sawest **THE FEET AND TOES**, part of potters' clay, and part of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.*
