The Sosa mistake. U.S. President George W. Bush is famous for humorously acknowledging that his "biggest mistake" occurred when he was a managing partner of the Texas Rangers baseball team. The admitted mistake was that he traded Sammy Sosa, who went on to become a superstar, to the Chicago White Sox. The comment by Bush was in response to questions about his admission of any mistakes he has made as President because the majority of the people in the U.S. feel as though he has made serious strategic blunders, the largest of which was the invasion and occupation of Iraq.



Key Understanding: The Sosa mistake and the Sousa mistake. The "Sosa mistake" that George W. Bush made as a former managing partner of the Texas Rangers was ordained by the Lord to point to what most people consider to be the blunder of a Bush-led United States invasion and occupation of Iraq. Because the United States was in the role of a second (but counterfeit) 'Susa' Media-Persia in its invasion and occupation of Iraq, the event could be referred to as

President George W. Bush's 'Sousa mistake.' In short, the 'Sosa mistake' was for the prophetic purpose of pointing to the 'Susa (or Sousa) mistake.'
